



Contribution Regulation

The Association adopts a Contribution Regulation on the basis of § 3 para. 3 of the Articles of Association. The general meeting has instructed the board on 04.12.2020 to change the preliminary Contribution Regulation (from 23.03.2020) according to the points decided in the general meeting. The board has decided on 21.12.2020 the following Contribution Regulation. This version replaces the provisional Contribution Regulation.

§ 1 Principles

- (1) This Contribution Regulation regulates the details of an annual membership fee, which all members of Green Legal Impact Germany e.V. undertake to pay in accordance with the Articles of Association. They are not part of the Articles of Association. The General Assembly of Members is responsible for enacting and amending them.
- (2) The membership fees are used to cover the general costs of the association.

§ 2 Amount of membership fees for ordinary members

- (1) For ordinary members, the annual membership fee shall be at least 120.00 EUR. A reduced membership fee of 60,00 EUR per year will be granted e.g. to trainees, students and unemployed persons upon appropriate proof.
- (2) In deviation from paragraph 1, the minimum annual membership fee for legal entities shall be EUR 1,000.00. Insofar as the legal entity predominantly pursues non-profit purposes, the minimum contribution shall be € 250.00.

§ 3 Amount of membership fees for supporting members

- (1) For supporting, non-voting members, the annual membership fee shall be at least 120.00 EUR. Among others, legal trainees, students and unemployed persons shall receive the reduced membership fee for supporting members of 60.00 EUR per year upon presentation of proof.
- (2) In deviation from paragraph 1, the following minimum annual membership fees shall apply for legal entities: 250.00 EUR for legal entities that predominantly pursue non-profit purposes, otherwise the minimum membership fee shall be 500.00 EUR. For economically active legal entities with a total annual turnover of between 500,000 EUR and 1 million EUR, a contribution of at least 1,000.00 EUR is recommended, and for economically active legal entities with an annual turnover of more than 1 million EUR, a minimum contribution of 1,500.00 EUR is recommended.

§ 4 Exemption

The Board of Directors may, upon application, exempt individual members from the payment of membership dues on a one-time or permanent basis.

§ 5 Due date, payment

- (1) The membership fee is due on January 31st of a calendar year. If a member joins the Association during the year, the membership fee shall be due within two weeks of the date specified in the written confirmation of admission in accordance with § 3 para. 2 sentence 4 of the Articles of Association.
- (2) Members shall provide the Association with a written direct debit authorization. Otherwise, the annual fees shall be transferred to an account designated by the Association.

§ 6 Entry into force

The contribution regulations comes into force on January 15, 2021.
